

## Progress 8 Trend



**Progress 8 (P8) is an indicator of how well a student has achieved, compared to students of similar ability nationally.**

When the new leadership team took over, Cockermouth School students were achieving well, but just below the high levels they were predicted to achieve.

Since then we have seen four years of continuous and rapid improvement.

In 2019, Cockermouth School students achieved a P8 of 0.53.

This means that on average, each student in over half of their GCSE's, achieved a whole grade higher than students of similar ability nationally.

**This places us in the top 10% of schools and is testimony to the continued hard work of our students and staff over the last four years.**
